

Ensure Your Vote is COUNTED on Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 5, 2024

CONFIRM: Pre-Requisites

- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Be at least 18 years of age by Election Day, Tuesday, November 5, 2024
- Be a resident of Delaware
- If you are a felon, you are eligible to vote as long as you have served your sentence (including parole) and your convictions were not for [disqualifying felonies](#)
- Not be adjudged mentally incompetent

STEP 1: Register to Vote & Check Accuracy

Check the Accuracy of your [current voter registration](#) or Register to Vote for the first time [online](#), by [mail](#), or [in-person](#). All applications must be RECEIVED by your county [Department's Office](#) by **Saturday, October 12, 2024**. If you do not register by this date, then you CANNOT vote in the 2024 General Election; however, you can *update* your record on election day at your polling location. ***Don't delay, pledge to check the accuracy of your voter status or register to vote by Thursday, September 12, 2024.***

STEP 2: Request Your Absentee Ballot (If Needed)

Delaware will only allow registered voters to **apply** for an [absentee ballot](#) IF they meet [specific requirements](#) (listed on the application). If you are submitting your request for an absentee ballot by [online](#), by [mail](#), or [in-person](#), it must be COMPLETED, SIGNED, and RECEIVED by the [Department's Office](#) in your county by **Friday, November 1, 2024**. Track the status of your application on the Delaware's [Voter Portal](#). ***Don't delay, if you need to vote by Absentee Ballot, pledge to return your Absentee Ballot application by Tuesday, October 15, 2024.***

STEP 3: Cast Your Vote

ABSENTEE BALLOT: Cast your vote by **mailing-in** or **hand-delivering** your COMPLETED and SIGNED absentee ballot, which must be RECEIVED by your county [Department's Office](#) by **Election Day, Tuesday, November 5, 2024** by **8:00pm**. ***Don't delay, pledge to mail in your Absentee Ballot by Tuesday, October 22, 2024.***

- OR -

IN-PERSON VOTING: Cast your vote **early in-person** at your local **Early Voting locations** (check your county [Department's Office](#) for locations) from **Friday, October 25, 2024** to **Sunday, November 3, 2024**. Early Voting locations will be open from **11:00am to 7:00pm** the **first five days** of early voting and from **7:00am to 7:00pm** **all other days**. If you choose to vote IN-PERSON on **Election Day, Tuesday, November 5, 2024**, polling hours take place between **7:00am** until **8:00pm** at your correct [Polling Location](#). Always be sure to bring your government ID with you. ***Don't delay, pledge to cast your vote in-person during Early Voting and avoid the crowds.***

STEP 4: Celebrate Your Vote

Celebrate being an ArtsVote leader by posting a selfie of you mailing-in your ballot or wearing an "I Voted" sticker on social media.
