

ArtsVote in Delaware

(Updated as of 7/10/24)



Ensure Your Vote is COUNTED on Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 5, 2024

CONFIRM: Pre-Requisites

- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Be at least 18 years of age by Election Day, Tuesday, November 5, 2024
- Be a resident of Delaware
- If you are a felon, you are eligible to vote as long as you have served your sentence (including parole) and your convictions
 were not for <u>disqualifying felonies</u>
- Not be adjudged mentally incompetent

STEP 1: Register to Vote & Check Accuracy

Check the Accuracy of your <u>current voter registration</u> or Register to Vote for the first time <u>online</u>, by <u>mail</u>, or <u>in-person</u>. All applications must be RECEIVED by your county <u>Department's Office</u> by Saturday, October 12, 2024. If you do not register by this date, then you CANNOT vote in the 2024 General Election; however, you can *update* your record on election day at your polling location. *Don't delay, pledge to check the accuracy of your voter status or register to vote by Thursday, September 12, 2024.*

STEP 2: Request Your Absentee Ballot (If Needed)

Delaware will only allow registered voters to **apply** for an **absentee ballot** IF they meet **specific requirements** (listed on the application). If you are submitting your request for an absentee ballot by **online**, by **mail**, or **in-person**, it must be COMPLETED, SIGNED, and RECEIVED by the **Department's Office** in your county by **Friday**, **November 1**, **2024**. Track the status of your application on the Delaware's **Voter Portal**. **Don't delay**, **if you need to vote by Absentee Ballot**, **pledge to return your Absentee Ballot application by Tuesday**, **October 15**, **2024**.

STEP 3: Cast Your Vote

ABSENTEE BALLOT: Cast your vote by **mailing-in** or **hand-delivering** your COMPLETED and SIGNED absentee ballot, which must be RECEIVED by your county **Department's Office** by **Election Day, Tuesday, November 5, 2024** by **8:00pm. Don't delay, pledge to mail in your Absentee Ballot by Tuesday, October 22, 2024.**

– OR –

IN-PERSON VOTING: Cast your vote early in-person at your local Early Voting locations (check your county <u>Department's Office</u> for locations) from Friday, October 25, 2024 to Sunday, November 3, 2024. Early Voting locations will be open from 11:00am to 7:00pm the first five days of early voting and from 7:00am to 7:00pm all other days. If you choose to vote IN-PERSON on Election Day, Tuesday, November 5, 2024, polling hours take place between 7:00am until 8:00pm at your correct Polling Location. Always be sure to bring your government ID with you. Don't delay, pledge to cast your vote in-person during Early Voting and avoid the crowds.

STEP 4: Celebrate Your Vote
